Mandate:

To operate a centre for the performing arts serving Brandon and western Manitoba.

Authority:

The Letters Patent (Oct. 12/73)

Responsibilities:

The members administer the affairs of BMAC based on the by-laws of the Corporation.

Membership:

The Board is established under the Corporation's by-laws. Three members are appointed by the City of Brandon and three members are appointed by OIC; the six appointed members elect one additional member. Members of the Board elect the Chair.

Length of Terms:

The Corporation's by-laws provide for appointments of governors for terms of one-year and members may be reappointed.

Desirable Expertise:

- Appointments should represent the Westman region and it is desirable to have least one from outside Brandon.
- Patrons of the BCAC and the performing arts
- Should be known and accessible to the community
- Finance
- Volunteer boards
- Capital planning
- Fundraising

Time Commitment:

One meeting per month, September – June, held over the lunch hour and lasting approximately 1-2 hours on the last Wednesday of each month.

Remuneration:

No remuneration is provided to members. BMAC pays for mileage and provides lunch for meetings.
